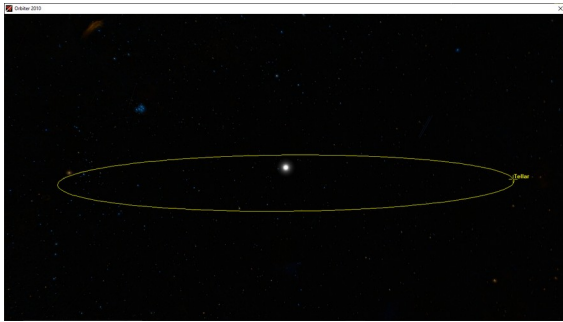


STPSP: TELLAR

Introduction

STPSP: Tellar is an auxiliary entry in the *Star Trek* Planetary Systems Project (STPSP). This is an attempt to accurately portray the major planetary systems in the *Star Trek* universe (with some conjecture, mostly in the form of some ideas of mine.) A fan of the series almost since birth, I wanted to recreate the planetary systems so that it would be possible to create scenarios in them. The Tellar system is home to one planet, two moons, and one surface base. The planetary arrangement is a basic representation based on on-screen evidence. The Tellar-B mesh is originally by NightHawke, with some modifications by me. The one surface base requires the STPSP: Andor add-on for meshes. You will require the *Nova*-class starship, *Danube*-class runabout, and Tellarite Cruiser add-ons for the scenarios. As for this system, I promise that you won't be disappointed. Enjoy!

System viewed from 115 million KM

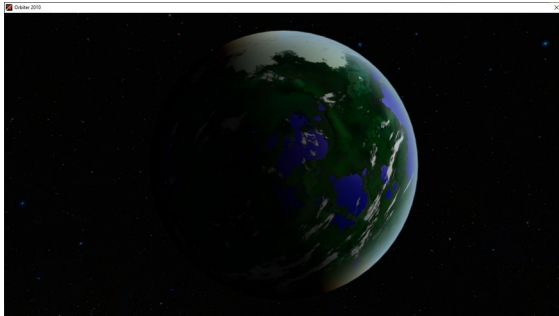
Primary Star: 61 Cygni A

The Tellarites

The Tellarites are a humanoid species characterized by their sunken eyes as well as their pig-like noses and facial features. Tellarites are shorter on average than humans. We are provided with relatively little information on the Tellarites, apart from the fact that they have a reputation for being physically sturdy and a tendency towards strong emotions. Tellarites often enjoy a good argument, to the point they consider it something of a sport. For this reason, many believe that Tellarites make excellent politicians.

However, in some circles, Tellarites are known to engage in dubious forms of business, including illegal mining operations. Tellarite cuisine largely consists primarily of raw fruits and vegetables, although they also consider canine-type creatures something of a delicacy. The Tellarites are one of the founding members of the United Federation of Planets, alongside humans, Vulcans, and Andorians, the latter of whom they engaged in some border conflicts with prior to the Federation's founding.

Notable Tellarites:

Skalaar: Ship captain turned bounty hunter.

Gral: Ambassador at the time of the Federation's founding.

Naarg: Aide to Ambassador Gral.

Gav: Ambassador in 2267, assassinated prior to Babel Conference
