


STPSP: ROMULUS

Introduction

STPSP: Romulus is part six of the *Star Trek* Planetary Systems Project (STPSP) This is an attempt to accurately simulate the major planetary systems in the *Star Trek* universe (with some conjecture, mostly in the form of some ideas of mine.) A fan of the series almost since birth, I wanted to recreate the systems so that it would be possible to create scenarios in them. The Romulus system is home to four planets, three moons, and one surface base. The planetary arrangement is based on a chart seen in the film *Star Trek: Nemesis*. The Romulan capital city mesh is originally by gattispilot. You will require the *Sovereign-class* starship, *Danube-class* runabout, *D'Deridex-class* Romulan Warbird, *Mogai-class* (AKA *Valdore-class*) Romulan Warbird, *Galor-class* Cardassian warship, and *Negh'var-class* Klingon warship add-ons for the scenarios. As for the system, I promise that you won't be disappointed. Enjoy!

System viewed from 625 million KM









The Romulans

The Romulans are a humanoid species characterized by pointed ears, green blood, and a ridge on their forehead. They are descended from Vulcans who left Vulcan in about 300 AD. Although they resemble the Vulcans, they are considerably different culturally. They have been described as being passionate and aggressive, but honourable people. The Romulan government is controlled by a Praetor, with a Senate to control most political decisions. The Romulans have had a long history of conflict with the Federation, including the Earth-Romulan War (2155 – 2160) and the infamous Khitomer Massacre (2346). However, during the Dominion War, the two powers officially ended their hostilities to fight the Dominion. Examples of Romulan cuisine include Romulan Ale (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦ ᑭᑭᑦ, *kali-fal*), a blue-coloured and very potent alcoholic drink that was banned in the Federation prior to the Dominion War, and Romulan molluscs.

Notable Romulans:

Valdore (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): High-ranking military official during Earth-Romulan War.

Caithlin Dar (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ ᑭᑭᑦ): Representative to the Federation in 2287.

Nanclus (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Ambassador to the Federation in 2293, became involved in conspiracy to sabotage Khitomer Peace Conference.

Tokath (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Former commander and founder of secret Klingon/Romulan joint colony on Carraya IV.

Telek R'Mor (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦ): Scientist and functionary of the Romulan Astrophysical Academy as of 2351.

Tomalak (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Notable commander of an unidentified Warbird.

Alidar Jarok (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦ): Former admiral and alleged traitor.

Toreth (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Commander of IRW *Khazara* in 2369.

Taris (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Commander of IRW *Haakona* in 2365.

Pardek (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Senator who represented Romulus at Khitomer Peace Conference in 2293 and later became involved in Sela's attempted invasion of Vulcan.

Vreenak (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Senator in 2374, assassinated by Elim Garak.

Neral (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Praetor in 2375, succeeded by Hiren.

Hiren (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Praetor in 2379, assassinated later that year by Shinzon.

Tal'aura (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Senator who initially conspired with but later opposed Shinzon in 2379.

Donatra (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Commander of IRW *Valdore* who initially conspired with but later fought Shinzon in 2379.

Sela (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦ): Daughter (likely a clone) of alternate Natasha Yar.

The Remans

The Remans are a humanoid species with grey skin, bald heads, pointed ears, and long teeth. We are provided with very little information on the Remans. We know that their homeworld, Remus, is tidally locked towards its parent star and therefore suffers from extreme temperature variations. As a result, the Remans live on the dark side. Remans, up to a certain point, were severely persecuted by the Romulans. Presumably, the Remans are native to the system, thus explaining the considerable physical differences between them and the Romulans.

Notable Remans:

Shinzon (ᑭᑭᑦᑲᑦᑲᑦ): Technically a human clone (though raised by Remans), as well as a traitor, who attempted to commit genocide against Earth in 2379.
